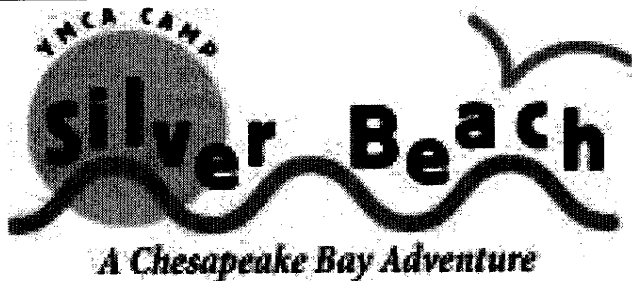

**The Rotary Foundation Naming opportunities**

A named gift is an outright contribution to Annual Programs Fund that provides immediate funding for a program.

**Sustaining Member:** Anyone who contributes US\$100 or more per year to the Annual Programs Fund is automatically recognized as a Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member. All gifts cumulatively count toward other Foundation recognition programs.

**Benefactor:** You may become a Benefactor by making the Permanent Fund a beneficiary in your estate plans or by donating \$1,000 or more to the fund outright.

**Bequest Society:** Couples or individuals who have made commitments of \$10,000 or more in their estate plans, such as in a will, living trust, or through whole or universal life insurance, can become Bequest Society members.

**Paul Harris Fellow:** Anyone who contributes \$1,000 or more to the Annual Programs Fund or has that amount contributed in their name may become a Paul Harris Fellow.

**Major Donor:** The Rotary Foundation recognizes couples or individuals whose combined personal outright or cumulative giving has reached \$10,000. All outright contributions made to the Foundation are included in this total, regardless of the gift designation.

**Arch C. Klumph Society:** Donors whose cumulative gifts total \$250,000 or more will become members of the Arch C. Klumph Society and have their photos displayed permanently in the Arch C. Klumph Gallery at RI headquarters.
