Labor Day Facts (from the US Department of Labor)

Labor Day is defined as "a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country."

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882. In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday. The idea spread with the growth of labor organizations, and in 1885 Labor Day was celebrated in many industrial centers of the country.

The founder of Labor Day is still in dispute. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a cofounder of the American Federation of Labor suggested the holiday. However, more recent research indicates that Matthew Maguire proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.
