November is Rotary Foundation Month -A brief history of PolioPlus

Since PolioPlus began in 1985, Rotary's vast network of 1.2 million members has contributed money, volunteer time, and networking expertise to the polio eradication effort.

To date, 210 countries, territories and areas around the world are polio free. As of June 2007, Rotary has committed more than \$633 million to global polio eradication.

The PolioPlus program helps Rotary fund operational costs, such as transportation, vaccine delivery, social mobilization, and training of health workers, and support surveillance activities.
