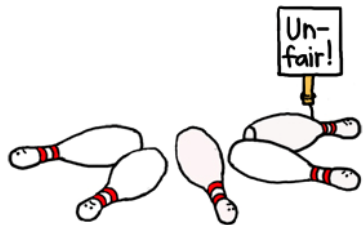
Jim Eilertsen spoke to the club last week about the Good News Jail & Prison Ministry.
