**TODAY IN HISTORY**

**1607, Jamestown founded.** Some 100 English colonists settle along the west bank of the James River in Virginia to found Jamestown, the first permanent English settlement in North America.

**1846, President Polk declares war on Mexico.** The U.S. Congress overwhelmingly votes in favor of President James K. Polk's request to declare war on Mexico in a dispute over Texas.
