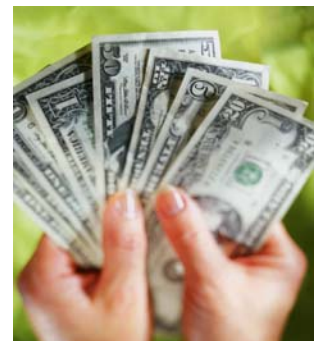

Today is Veterans Day, a holiday to honor all military veterans.

World War I officially ended when the Treaty of Versailles was signed on June 28, 1919. However, fighting ceased seven months earlier when an armistice between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month.

In November 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day

In June 1954, Congress changed the law by striking out the word "Armistice" and inserting in its place the word "Veterans."
