JANUARY IS ROTARY AWARENESS MONTH

- What is Rotary? To the average Cape Henry Rotarian, the answer is pretty simple.
- But take a minute to think about your friends, family, and co-workers. Most of them may remember that you have a meeting every Wednesday morning.
- But do they know that:
 - ◆ there are more than 1.2 million Rotarians in nearly 34,000 clubs around the globe (including 46 total Rotarians in 4 clubs in Afghanistan)?
 - ◆ since 1947, Rotarians worldwide have contributed more than \$2.4 billion to the Rotary Foundation to help Rotary do good in the world?
 - ◆ Rotary launched its PolioPlus program in 1985 and since that time the global eradication of polio has been the organization's top priority?
 - ◆ Rotary is raising \$200 million in response to grants totaling \$355 million from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to eradicate polio?
 - ◆ The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise, and in particular to encourage and foster:
 - FIRST. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
 - SECOND. High ethical standards in business and professions;
 - THIRD. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life
 - FOURTH. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace.
