Revenue

Rotary International's revenue is received primarily from annual membership dues. **In 2008-09, Rotary International's total revenue was \$66.7 million. In 2008-09, The Rotary Foundation's total revenue was \$59.9 million.**

Expenses

Rotary International's expenses are reported as operating expenses (functions associated with serving Rotarians, such as governance, membership programs and services, and management) and services and other activities (activities that generate income to offset the expenses incurred). **In 2008-09, Rotary International's total expenses were \$83.5 million and The Rotary Foundation's total expenses were \$187.8 million, of which \$167.6 million was for programs in three principal program areas: Humanitarian Grants, Educational Programs, and PolioPlus.**
